

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT INSPIRED THE CREATION OF THE HASANAH GOLD THREADS AWARDS?

HGTA was created to recognise and celebrate the artisans, designers, and communities that preserve and promote heritage textiles. It aims to congregate the best of the country's material culture, bringing together for the first time on one platform our major textile traditions and their makers.

HOW DO THESE AWARDS CONTRIBUTE TO THE PRESERVATION OF INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE?

The Awards help raise awareness about the importance of preserving intangible cultural heritage. They contribute to the transmission of traditional knowledge and skills from one generation to the next, ensuring the continuity of cultural practices.

ARE THERE ANY SPECIFIC CHALLENGES FACED BY ARTISANS AND COMMUNITIES INVOLVED IN HERITAGE TEXTILES PRODUCTION?

Yes, we are planning a series of demonstrations, workshops and talks at Pavilion Bukit Jalil, KL and The Datai Langkawi, Kedah, as well as a roadshow of HGTA 2023 winners' exhibitions and HGTA information sessions, in Penang and the East Coast. A full schedule will be released soon.

WHAT ROLE CAN GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND POLICYMAKERS PLAY IN SUPPORTING HERITAGE FABRIC INITIATIVES?

Government agencies and policymakers play a crucial role in supporting heritage fabric initiatives by providing funding, creating policies that protect traditional textile practices, and promoting cultural heritage preservation through legislation and incentives for artisans and communities.
